I am requesting funding for the City of Jacinto City for Water Main and Fire Hydrant Improvements project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Jacinto City, TX, located at 1301 Mercury Dr, Jacinto City, TX 77029. The funding would be used for replacing 17,120 linear feet of 84-year-old steel water pipes with polypropylene pipes and for installing 21 new fire hydrants. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will improve water delivery, increase fire flow capacity, reduce the likelihood of service disruptions, and enhance overall public safety for Jacinto City, TX.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
